- \*Realise that the UK is surrounded by seas and to know their names.

**In P.E. we will learn to...**

- \*Practise the athletic skills of running throwing and jumping.
- \*Run at different speeds *e.g jogging, sprinting.*
- \*Throw into differing targets.
- \*Practise and perform 5 different jumps *e.g landing on two feet, landing on one foot.*

- \*Decide on the suitability of a specific material for each part of the house.
- \*Investigate ways to make windows/doors open and shut.

- \*Investigate how to make shapes and patterns when weaving.
